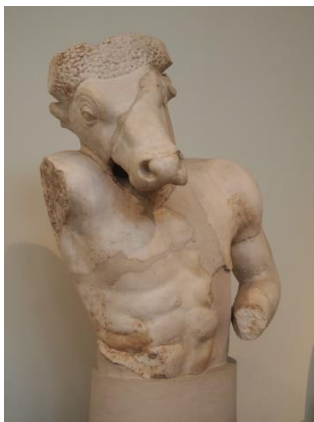
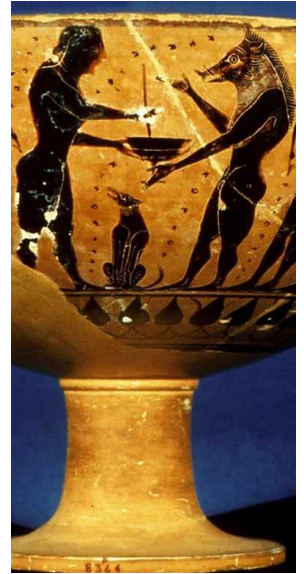
New course

Ovid's work will take us on a fascinating and wide-ranging exploration of human life, philosophy, literature, ancient history, ancient religion, love and attraction, and much more.
